## ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

**RV DAY PARKING WILL BE ALLOWED TO ENTER GATE #1 - No overnight parking will be allowed! Anyone who chooses not to abide by this rule will be asked to move their RV to the overnight RV parking area through Gate #3 & will be required to pay the appropriate overnight fees. Non-compliance will result in your RV being towed at your expense.**

Handicap parking for all RVs will now be in the west parking lot. There will be parking for automobiles/vans & SUVs in the first row of the easterly parking lot. This is on a first-come, first-serve basis. **PARKING SPACES CANNOT BE SAVED FROM DAY TO DAY. THE HANDICAP PARKING LOT WILL BE MONITORED CLOSELY & citations will be given when it is deemed necessary. **Crates cannot be set up under the show tent until 15 minutes before judging.**

**Crates must be removed immediately after judging.**

No strollers under the tent.

There are shower & toilet facilities in the 4-H Forum Buildings for people. NO DOGS PERMITTED IN THE SHOWERS OR LAVATORIES.

Excellent food will be served in the cafeteria Friday, Saturday & Sunday starting at 7:00 AM. Snacks will be available Friday at the food stand.

No private exercise pens allowed in the Forum Building.

No private tents/pop-ups will be allowed within 20 feet of any ring.

The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is expressly understood that exhibitors will exercise control & restraint over their children at all times.

3. CLUB MEMBERS & WORKERS WITH APPROPRIATE PASS

## OUT OF STATE EXHIBITORS

Note: Exhibitors from outside Wisconsin must comply with the following regulations: Wisconsin Department of Agriculture Rule Enacted in 1954 - No person shall import a dog over 6 months of age into this state unless it is accompanied by an interstate health certificate including thereon a vaccination for rabies, etc. Such vaccination shall be conducted not more than 12 months prior to entry.

Provided that when chick embryo vaccination is used, such vaccination shall be conducted not more than 36 months prior to entry.

An interstate health certificate shall be executed by a veterinarian of the state of origin showing animals identified thereon have been inspected & no infectious diseases disclosed & to include a rabies report.

**These Clubs do not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.**

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp: Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers & Bulldogs.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). A \$3.00 AKC Recording Fee will be required for each entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 3) These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

**CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.**

There will be no refund for duplicate entries.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendents will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - None will be mailed.

All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. Checks are valid for 90 days. The Superintendent is not able to cash checks.

**RETURNED CHECKS/DECLINED CREDIT/DEBIT CARDS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. Checks will not be accepted. The Superintendent will add a fee for completing the transaction and/or reprocessing the entries. Repeated occurrences from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Superintendent.

The show giving Club, the Show Superintendent, their agents, employees, etc, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures or the "Agreement" on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by telegram prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Refunds of \$3.00 & less will not be issued due to the costs of processing.

An administrative fee of \$2.00 will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries.

**THESE RULES WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. Anyone who either ignores the directions of the Parks Staff at the gate or bypasses them in some manner will be subject to a show committee hearing, per the Waukesha Kennel Club, Inc.**

- Day RV Parking **ONLY** in Gate #1. **No overnight parking will be allowed. Anyone who chooses not to abide by this rule will be asked to move their RV to the overnight RV parking area through Gate #3 & will be required to pay the appropriate overnight fees. Non-compliance will result in your RV being towed at your expense.**
- **RVs wishing to camp overnight must enter through Gate #3.**
- No overnight RV parking will be allowed until after 12:00 pm on Wednesday.
- Parking access to Gate #3 will be limited to the following:
  - Recreational vehicles with proper parking forms displayed in the window.

**BRACE CLASS** - Two dogs of the same Breed or Variety of Breed with one or more common owner. Each dog which will compete in the Brace Class must be so noted on the entry form. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising **EACH** Brace must be so designated - "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2," etc.

**TEAM CLASS** - A Class for four dogs of the same Breed or Variety of Breed with one or more common owner and all dogs must be entered in another class.
