EXHIBITORS ENTRANCE – Enter fair grounds on Greenfield Avenue or 84th Street Entrance and follow signs to unloading area. Loading and unloading on the east side and south side of building. Exhibitors need entry ticket/ident card to enter building.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs, they will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule printed in the program. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged. There may be a break at the judge's discretion. The show giving club and secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. Being an unbenched show, you need to be at the show only in time for your judging and may leave any time after judging. The number before each Breed (variety) indicates the number of Regular Class dogs, Regular Class Bitches, Best of Breed (Variety) (Dogs-Bitches) and Non-regular class dogs or Bitches. For your convenience the following class divisions have been carefully tabulated, however, neither the Club or Show Secretary assumes responsibility for absolute accuracy.

Notice: Transfer of dogs from regular classes to Best of Variety competition must be made to the Show Secretary one half hour before the start of regular conformation judging.
